Splat-a-Day runs monthly, engaging local families with fun activities on a Saturday morning to keep everyone entertained; baking, playing and crafting.



The church supports the local Foodbank, part of the Trussell Trust network, which is run out of the building every Friday alongside a community cafe.

Little Fishes is the hugely popular toddlers group that welcomes locals and their pre-school children every Monday for conversation, support and play.



A monthly Autism Café as well as a Crossroads Sunday afternoon service look to meet the different learning needs of those in our community.





We run a youth group on Fridays for 11-16 year olds offering a safe space where the young people can have fun and find out more about the Christian faith.



Breakfasts that are geared to support men and women in the church and the wider community run most months alongside many other weekly, varied interest groups.

Wednesdays at Two is a group for older members of the church family; they meet to sing, have a meal together, share life and understand more about the journey of faith over a cup of tea each week.



We have seven small groups meeting weekly to explore the Christian faith more deeply and build stronger connections with each other. We regularly run Alpha courses for those starting on their faith journey.

If you sense God may be calling you to join us as our church leader, please email us enclosing your CV and a covering letter. It would be helpful if you explain why you have applied for this role, provide information on how you came to faith, and how God has led you in your ministry so far.

We will conduct the first stage of the selection process via a virtual meeting so that we can share more information on the ministry and vision of Saltisford, get to know you a little better and allow you to ask us questions.

We then plan to invite a short list of candidates to join us at Saltisford for an interview day during which you will meet the Leaders and several church members.

If you and we prayerfully consider it's right to explore things further, you would then be invited to join us for a weekend so that you can meet the whole church and join us in worship.

If together we discern that you're right for the role, we would anticipate a latest start date of Spring 2026, subject to mutual discussion.
